NDS's State of the Disability Sector Report 2022 is based on responses from 364 disability service providers from all over the country who took part in our annual State of the Disability Sector Survey. Here are some key findings of this year's report.



43% agreed NDIS policy reforms are heading in the right direction.



39% confident that Quality and Safeguarding Framework **supported quality of services**.



67% **agreed** Australia's **economy had worsened** in the past year.



11% agree NDIS Pricing and Regulation are conducive to innovative services responding to participants needs.



36% of organisations **predicting a loss** in 2022-23.



48% disagree DES policy reforms are heading in the right direction.



80% unable to provide services requested of them.



67% disagree the digital service model has improved employment opportunities for DES Participants.



83% reported **problems recruiting** disability support workers.



18% **agree** the environment for supports in employment providers is **more certain** than last year.
